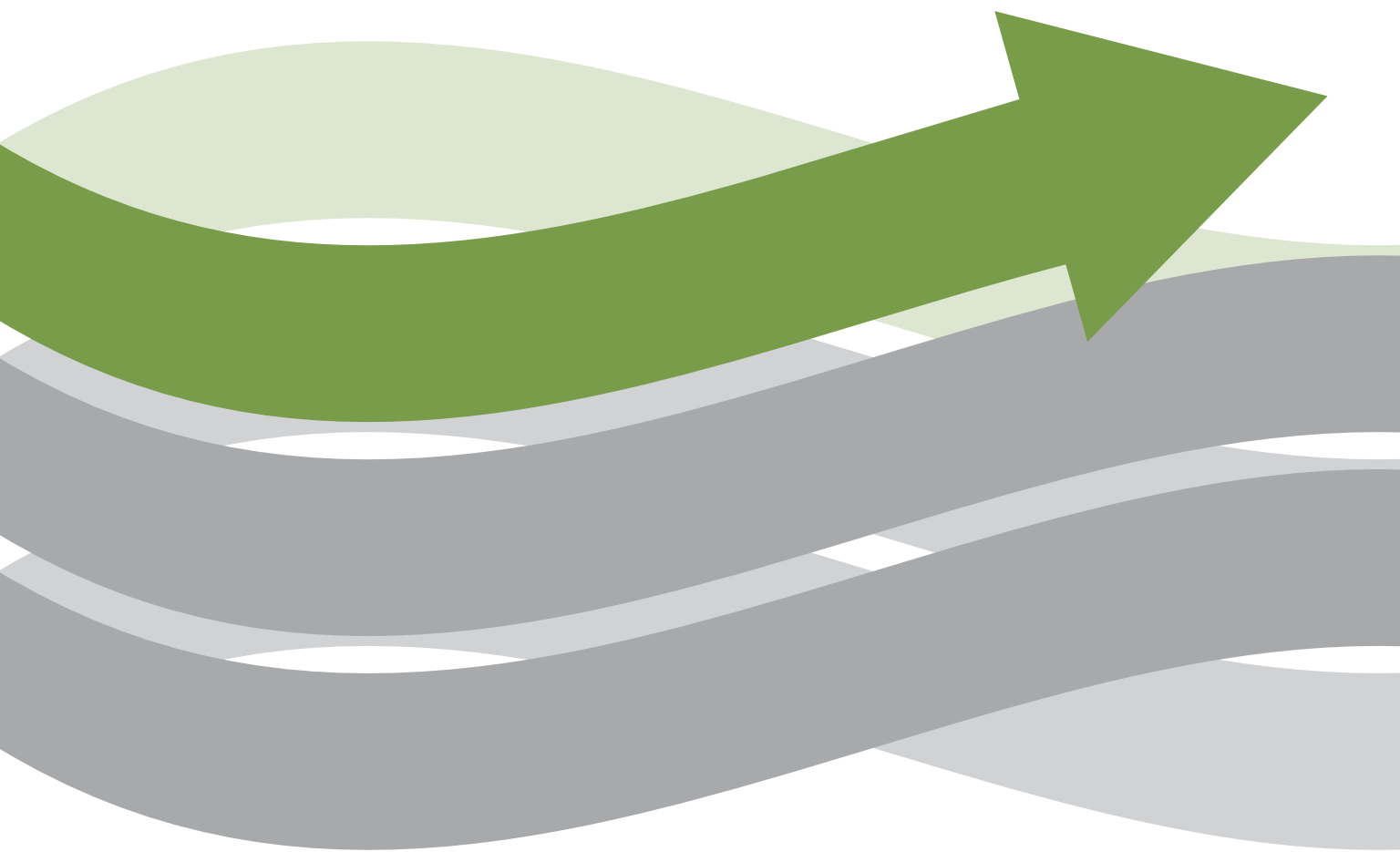

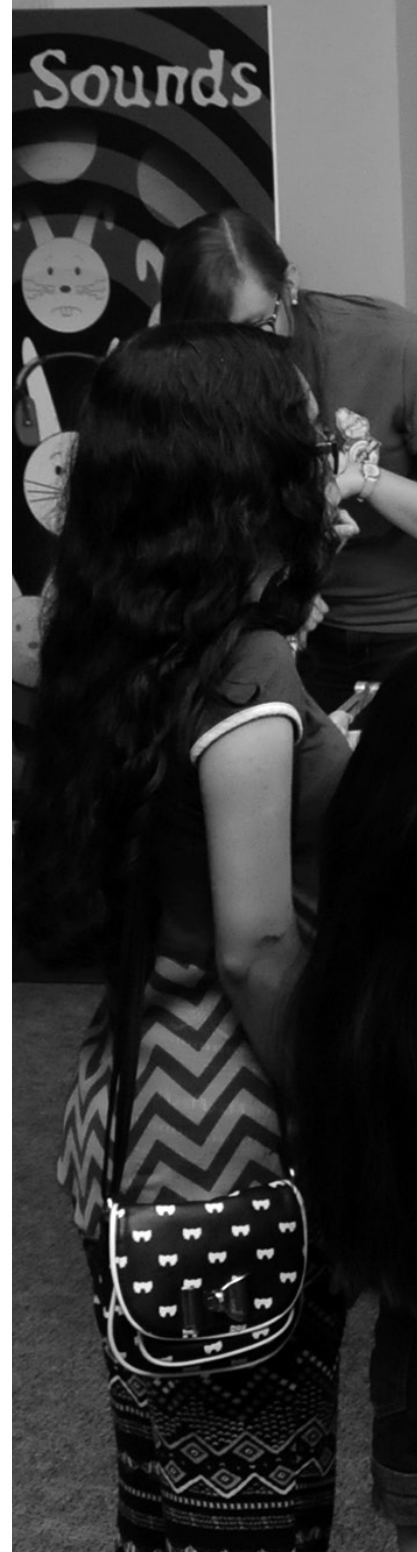

- Chapter Challenge Grants reward chapters who conduct initiatives in audiology advocacy, education, humanitarianism and fundraising.
- HEAR (Humanitarian, Educational and Awareness Resources) Chapter Grants support local, national, and international activities conducted by students across the United States.
- SOHH (Special Olympic Healthy Hearing) Chapter Grants provide funding for students who screen Special Olympic athletes during local, state, national, and international games.

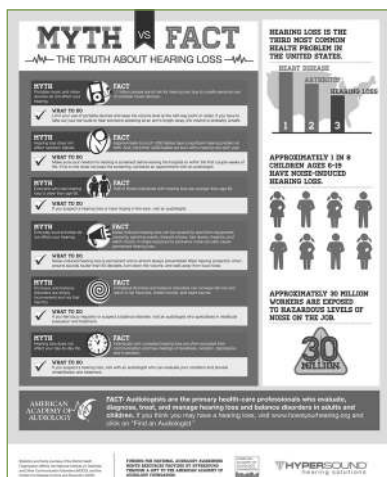
